The Positive Speaker Bureau (PSB) is a Positive Life NSW program that offers a range of trained, passionate and committed members of the community who are living with HIV. Our speakers give up to date information about HIV prevention, transmission and treatment whilst presenting a real life and personal experiences of living with HIV helping to reduce stigma and discrimination.

Integrating trained speakers who are living with HIV into the Life Ready curriculum is a powerful and inspirational way to present its content, helping to deepen student understanding of health issues, promote safety, responsibility and build student confidence.

## Life Ready

Our trained speakers represent the human face of HIV and come from a range of cultural backgrounds, ages and experiences as they help educate, reduce fear, myths and stigma.

Our positive speaker sessions align with the NSW Department of Education's Life Ready curriculum for Years 11 and 12, aiming to provide a meaningful educational impact.

## Booking a speaker

Our talks typically run for one hour, and many bookings include two speakers—a man and a woman living with HIV—to share their personal stories and highlight the distinct experiences shaped by gender.
